Highland Skating Club (HSC) membership is effective from the date this application and dues are received by the membership chair (but not earlier than 1 June 2009) through 30 June 2010. 2008-2009 members who do not renew their membership by 1 August 2009 will lose their membership privileges starting 2 August 2009. Those who are competing at the 2010 Northwest Pacific Championships (Regionals) are reminded that this application must be received by the membership chair before your competition entry forms will be signed.

Full Membership: Open to single adults or persons in a family (all related persons permanently residing at the same address) who are not current members of another US Figure Skating club. Junior members 17 years of age or younger have member privileges including skating, testing and competing and receive a US Figure Skating membership. Adult members 18 years of age or older also have voting privileges. The family or single adult receives "SKATING" magazine. To ensure that Junior members are represented in club decisions, it is a HSC's policy that Junior members have an adult family member as an Adult member of the Club. Persons who are ineligible or restricted as defined by US Figure Skating can not be a director or officer of the club.

Transfers from another US Figure Skating Member Club: Transfers of full membership into HSC from another US Figure Skating member club during the skating year are not required to pay the US Figure Skating portion of the membership fees; however, the membership will be held pending confirmation from US Figure Skating of their current good standing in the club they are transferring from. Contact the Highland SC Membership Chair for a Transfer Form.

Associate Membership: Open to those persons who are currently members of another US Figure Skating club. Associate members have skating, testing and other privileges granted by the Board but do not have voting privileges. Associate members 17 years of age or younger are not required to have an Adult Family Member join HSC.

Eligibility Status definitions: An "Eligible" person is someone who does not fall under one of the other categories and is in compliance with the eligibility rules of US Figure Skating (ER 1.02 & 1.03). An "Ineligible" person is someone who has violated USFSA eligibility rules and has not been reinstated by US Figure Skating (ER 6.00) . A "Readmitted" person is someone who was an ineligible person but who has been reinstated by US Figure Skating.
